

TIME BOUND

The Mathematics department of PSBB T.Nagar presented the project TIME BOUND as part of the International School Award Activity. This was held on 31st January 2019 at Shri. YGP auditorium.

The programme started with the invocation to the Almighty, by Baby Mrinalini of PreKG- B. Sanjana Bhat and Smriti of std 6C welcomed the Guest of honour, Ms. Inmaculada Gil Rodriguez, a Spanish teacher at Velammal Global School and two other visitors from Spain and introduced them to the audience.
