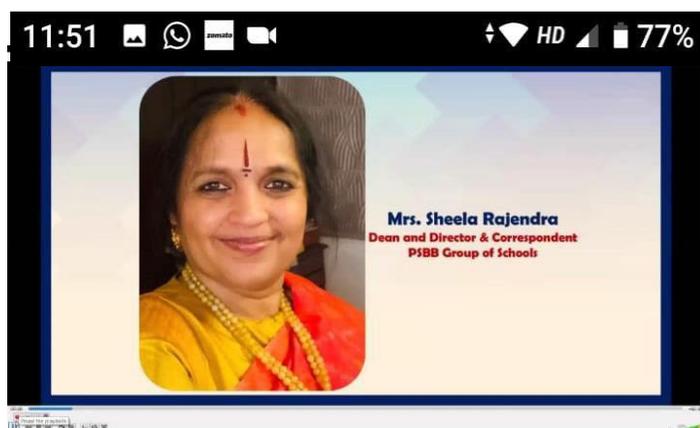


### Remote E-Reopening Day 2020 - PSBB Nungambakkam

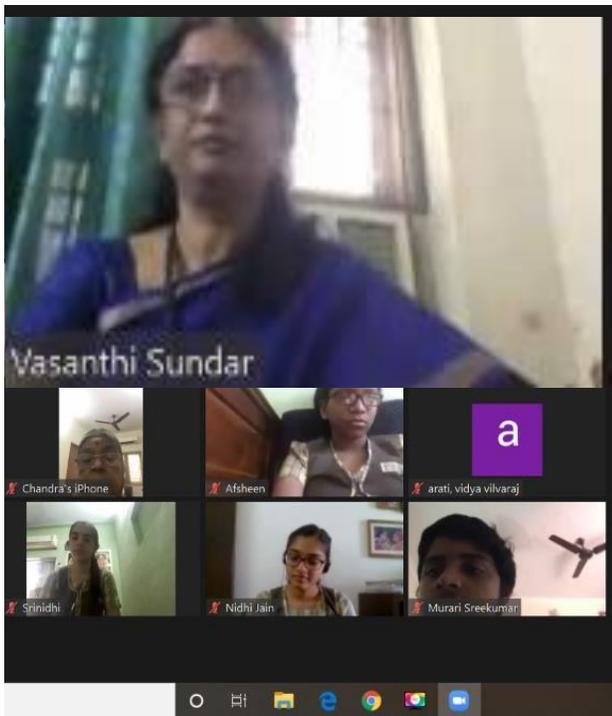
